Any foreign player who has a civil liability insurance covering him/her during a golf competition, and who can justify his/her index, this being attested by his/her club or his/her Federation.

8. Starting times:

Starts will be drawn randomly for the first three rounds and for the 4th round in the order of the cumulative gross classification, within each series.

9. Teeing Areas:

1st series Ladies - Blue Marks 2nd series Ladies - Red Marks

1st series Men - White Marks 2nd and 3rd series Men - Yellow Marks

Mixed Legends Series - Red or Yellow Marks

10. Recording:

Recording will be done at the following locations:

- 1. At the reception of the club house for "La Forêt"
- 2. In the starter's shed near the tee of hole n°1 for "La Mer".

The presence of all three players is essential for the recording of the scores.

11. Interruption of play: Please see the local rules.

12. Prizes:

After each round, a prize will be given to the best gross and net score of the day, in each round. The gross score takes precedence over the net score. If a player is not present at the prize-giving ceremony, his prize will be awarded by drawing lots.

These daily prizes are not cumulative, except for the general rankings. At the end of the 4 rounds prizes will be awarded to the 3 best cumulative gross and net scores in each handicap series, and the best gross and three best net scores in the Legend series.

A mixed "Nearest to the Pin" competition on hole 6 of "La Forêt" and on hole 7 of "La Mer".

On Thursday 29th August, there will be:

Longest Drive (one drive per player) per series on Hole 16 of "La Forêt" and on Hole 5 of "La Mer".

13. Tie-breaking:

In the event of a tie, the result will be decided as follows:

For the general rankings in Gross and Net:

On the last 18, 9, 6, 3 and last hole. If there is still a tie, the tie will be broken by going back to the hole-by-hole scores (17th, 16th, etc...)

14. Prize-giving ceremony:

A prize-giving ceremony will take place each day and will be held in the club house of Le Touquet Golf Club from 8pm. It will be an announcement of the results without cocktails (neither drinks, nor petits fours).
